


# editorial about the mag

Birthday cake. Because it's the shit, yo.


#### What is the furthest trip you have taken with this car and did you have any issues while doing so?

If you like my car now you will love it once I'm finished:)










Located just minutes off the PA turnpike in Norristown is small unit filled with European Volkswagen and Audi parts. This place called Orchid Euro is run by a humble guy named Jamie, which is the best place to score rare parts without having to locate and deal with shipping across the pond, exchange rates, etc. If you have a mk3 you definately need to hit this guy up if you need ecodes, euro bumpers, hatches and other random lighting parts or bits. I have gotten numerous things from him in the past and definately will continue to get stuff from him. I am lucky to have a place like this within an hour or so drive.  $\heartsuit$ 







#### Who are you and where are you from?

I'm Jamie and I run Orchid Euro. I live in Pottstown, PA which is a suburb of Philadelphia, but originally I'm from Scotland where I was born. I grew up in England before moving to the USA about 10 years ago.

When did you start orchid euro and what was the reason or inspiration for doing so? I started it with a friend about 5 years ago. We both had a knack for finding cool parts, and were sick of parts getting damaged or getting scammed when buying from Europe. As I guess as a lot of things do, it started as a part-time hobby and went from there. I went full time with the company a couple of years ago and haven't looked back since.

#### Tell me about some of the products you sell?

I love OEM parts, and try to stick to selling foreign market OEM and old aftermarket parts for watercooled Volkswagens (which is my personal favourite marque of choice) and to a lesser extent Audi as well as other special requests - Lancia, Land Rover, BMW etc. The cost and availability of brand new and NOS OEM European parts continues to get higher and harder to source as the cars we're all building get older, so often getting used OEM parts is the only choice. As we ship using our own full ocean containers we're not really limited in size to what we can bring so it comes down to price and availability. One of our signature products at the moment is the Right Hand Drive conversions.

#### How often do you get new shipments of stuff in?

On average we do a full tractor trailer worth every 10-14 weeks. We literally fly to Europe, locate and buy the parts, load them, import them, unload them and then retail them. It's often likened to doing what Mike from American Pickers (Antique Archeology) does if that helps explain it.



Tell me about some of the cars you currently own and/or working on?
Oh boy, this is quite a list. I should probably sell them all and just build one of two cars.. Here goes:

My 1997 GTI, which was a standard 2.0L 8v US Spec GTI. It's now being converted into a full Europear Golf Van complete with metal side window deletes, factory rear seat delete, and just to be different I installed a Euro Mk3 1.6L 8V 'reverse flow' engine which has the exhaust manifold on the front like a Honda.A 1956 NSU moped that I've got stashed away - it was made in the Neckarsulm factory which along with the rest of NSU became part of Audi and is where they still make some of their high end Aluminium cars to this day.A 1974 built Volkswagen Rabbit Swallowtail that I found and towed back eas from Nevada (November issue of Performance VW), which is getting a shaved normally aspirated 20V European engine installed.A 1983 Volkswagen Golf GTI which is on the ocean right now coming from England. It's a original Right Hand Drive Mk1 Golf with all the correct GTI trim, and is a car I always wanted to own. It's kind of a rusty crap heap, but it's all there so I'll have some fun rebuilding it a bit.A 2003 Freightliner Sprinter which is getting a full Volkswagen LT35 conversion with all the sheetmetal from Europe - doors, hood, lights, fenders, and all the sub-panels etc that go with it.And then I have my Polos, Lupo, Scirocco Storm, and my 16v VW Fox on Jenvey Throttle Bodies. And probably some more I'm forgetting.

What is your favorite flavor of icecream?

I'm going to go with Strawberry Swirl or a Raspberry Sorbet. I'm vegan, so it's either Sorbet or Soy for ic cream.


Is there anything else you wish to add or say?












## TO LISFEST


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










## DUBNRUB


